\$ 50,001.00 to \$100,000.00	<b>\$517.50</b> for the first \$50,000.00 plus \$5.50 for each additional \$1,000.00 or fraction thereof, to and including \$100,000.00
\$ 100,001.00 to \$500,000.00	<b>\$792.50</b> for the first \$100,000.00 plus \$4.25 for each additional \$1,000.00 or fraction thereof to and including \$500,000.00
\$ 500,001.00 to \$1,000,000.00	<b>\$2,492.50</b> for the first \$500,000.00 plus \$3.75 for each additional

Additional plan review required by changes, additions or revisions to approved plans (minimum charge – one half hour)*	\$147.00 per hour \$154.00 per hour (Engineering)
Plan review fee shall be 75 percent of the building permit fee
