Dear Resident/Business Owner:

Mamco, Inc. has been contracted by the City of Canyon Lake to construct the Railroad Canyon Road Widening Project. In General, Railroad Canyon Road will be widened from four to six lanes from Canyon Hills Road to Sorrel Lane. New traffic signals, drainage improvements, decorative landscaping, and retaining walls will also be constructed.

Construction will begin Monday, January 16, 2012 and should be completed within ten months.

Beginning January 17, westbound traffic will be limited to one lane for the duration of the project. Eastbound traffic will also be limited to one lane for a portion of the project that is estimated to be from March 15, 2012 to July 13, 2012. To facilitate construction, the Town Center East and West entrances must be closed for roughly ten days each (the entrances will not be closed at the same time). Construction of these two entrances will occur at separate times and adequate notice will be given prior to any closures. **Access to all residences and businesses will be maintained at all times.**

We kindly ask that all drivers observe the 35 mile per hour road work speed limit that will be posted for both your own safety and the safety of our crews. We understand that this project will be an inconvenience to you and others, but we will do our best to ensure that this inconvenience be held to an absolute minimum.

We think you will be pleased with the end project as it will "identify" Canyon Lake. The entire roadway and entries to the City of Canyon Lake will be enhanced to welcome visitors as well as residents.
