Canyon Lake Declares Local Emergency

FOR IMMEDIATE RELEASE

CANYON LAKE, CA – As a result of flooding, the City of Canyon Lake has declared a local emergency and an emergency operations center has been activated at City Hall. Canyon Lake has closed the North Causeway on Vacation Drive and Railroad Canyon Road/Goetz Road at Salt Creek.

There is one lane open for traffic at the Main Causeway on Canyon Lake Drive South with anticipation of full closure in the near future. These closures may remain in effect even after the rain has stopped. Residents are encouraged to plan ahead for the next day's commute.

Due to these closures, the city has been divided between causeways into three sections, each staffed with a deputy, a fire engine, and a volunteer area coordinator from the city's Disaster Preparedness Committee.
