

## Canyon Lake Road Improvements Provide for City's Future

Pot Holes to Vanish: Work is slated to start on a project to repair and repave the eastbound lanes of Railroad Canyon Road. Earlier this year, the Canyon Lake City Council approved a contract to rehabilitate the eastbound stretches of the road. The planned improvements include grinding and overlay of the eastbound lanes to remove damaged areas. The work is set to start July 6 and is timed to occur during the school district's summer vacation.

With the road work just a few weeks away, the City will not be filling pot holes along eastbound Railroad Canyon Road for the time being, saving an average of \$3,000 each time crews come out to make such repairs. Thank you for your patience.

The City has received notice that Eastern Municipal Water District's current project being performed by Genesis Construction on Railroad Canyon Road/Newport Road should be finished by the end of June. That project must be completed before the City can begin the eastbound lane rehabilitation project.

Beautiful Blooms: Beginning June 11, landscape crews from Sunshine Nursery will be adding some color and conservation-minded greenery to the center median of Railroad Canyon Road between the entry sign and the eastern end of the Canyon Lake Towne Center. This roadway project includes replacing irrigation lines and planting the median with shrubs, flowers and other plants that thrive on reclaimed water. Through an agreement with the Elsinore Valley Water District the City of Canyon Lake uses reclaimed water along the landscaped median on Railroad Canyon Road. The work should be complete by June 25, 2008.

Barring unforeseen delays, the road and median projects should be completed by the end of July.

Please remember to drive the speed limit and to pay special attention to reduced speeds in construction zones.
