



**CALIFORNIA GREW BY 0.8 PERCENT IN 2010**

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**SACRAMENTO**— The California Department of Finance released its latest population report today showing that California has 37,511,000 residents as of January 1, 2011. The state added almost 287,000 new residents in 2010.

The report shows preliminary January 2011, as well as revised January 2010, population data for the cities. The California Department of Finance population estimates incorporate 2010 Census counts as the benchmark. Therefore, the population estimates for 2010 and 2011 published in this report might be noticeably different from the previous year estimates. Highlights include:

- California's statewide housing growth in 2010 continued to reflect the downturn in the housing industry by adding only 44,649 housing units. Finance's housing estimates show a steady reduction in residential construction since the peak year of 2005, when the state added 197,477 new units; in 2006, 172,458 units were added; in 2007, there were 131,841 additional units; in 2008, 86,516 were added; and in 2009, only 63,036 units were added. These housing unit estimates are based on the annual housing unit change surveys Finance collects directly from local governments.
- The City of Los Angeles, California's largest city, has reached a population of 3,810,129. Los Angeles grew by over 17,000 persons during 2010. San Diego, California's second largest city, now has a population of 1,311,882 and added over 10,000 persons during the year. San Jose, California's third largest city, now has a population of 958,789 and added almost 13,000 persons during the year. With the 2010 Census counts used as the new benchmark, the populations of Los Angeles, San Diego, and San Jose begin this decade with lower population estimates compared to last year's report.
- Other notable changes that have occurred as a result of the new 2010 Census population benchmark include the cities of Oxnard, Glendale, and Huntington Beach beginning this decade with populations below 200,000. Last year all three cities had estimated populations over 200,000. This leaves 18 cities in California with populations above 200,000. The total number of cities with a population above 100,000 remains at 69. The 2010 Census population benchmark left South Gate and Mission Viejo below the 100,000 population mark while El Cajon and Santa Maria have reached the 100,000 mark for the first time.

- In the top ten city population rankings, Sacramento (469,566) moved ahead of Long Beach (463,894) to rank sixth while Bakersfield (351,443) climbed to the ninth position pushing Santa Ana (325,228) out of the top ten.
- The City of Desert Hot Springs in Riverside County ranked as the fastest growing city in California, increasing by 5.9 percent. The bulk of the growth in Desert Hot Springs came from the annexation of 447 housing units from unincorporated Riverside County. The next four fastest growing cities were Beaumont in Riverside County (4.7 percent), Lathrop in San Joaquin County (4.0 percent), Dinuba in Tulare County (3.5 percent), and Irvine in Orange County (3.3 percent). The above cities added a proportionally large number of new residents from recent housing increases or from additional occupancy resulting from previously reported housing units.
- The biggest numeric increases typically occurred in some of the state's largest cities – Los Angeles (17,023), San Jose (12,561), San Diego (10,347), and San Francisco (7,831).
- The 2010 report lists 481 California cities, of which 442 had gains in population, 32 lost population, and seven experienced no change.
- The new city of Eastvale incorporated in October 2010 in Riverside County with an estimated current population of 54,303.

Other Highlights include:

The 2010 relocation of California's prison population among various facilities within California, and to other states, resulted in the overall number of incarcerated persons declining for the fourth year in a row, down by 10,403 to 171,561 inmates statewide. The largest prison declines occurred in California City (-1,351) in Kern County where contract changes resulted in inmate restructuring. Other significant losses include Corcoran (-1,118) in Kings County, Avenal (-892) in Kings County, and Blythe (-858) in Riverside County. Soledad in Monterey County (+694), Unincorporated San Joaquin County (+267), and Unincorporated Marin County (+196) had notable gains in prison population.

Background Information:

These population estimates are produced annually by the Department of Finance for use by local areas to calculate their annual appropriations limit. The State Controller's Office uses Finance's estimates to update their payment population figures for distribution of state subventions to cities and counties, and to comply with various state codes. Additionally, estimates are used for research and planning purposes by federal, state and local agencies, the academic community, and the private sector.

Changes to the housing stock are used to prepare the annual city population estimates presented in this report. Estimated occupancy of housing units and the number of persons per household further determine population levels. Changes in city housing stocks result from new construction, demolitions, housing unit conversions, and annexations. The sub-county estimates are then controlled to independently produced county estimates.
