We all agree that there needs to be a way to reduce water demands from landscapes without a decline in landscape quality or quantity. The city encourages water efficiency landscape. A list of drought tolerant plants can be found by visiting www.cityofcanyonlake.com.

If you are planning to rehabilitate your landscaping or irrigation and the project cumulatively exceeds 1500 square feet in size, you are required to obtain a permit and submit plans to City Hall. For \$80 the City's landscape architect will review the plans for water efficient landscaping, water conservation and appropriate use of irrigation technology and management. Residents are encouraged to submit plans even if their remodel is less than 1500 square feet in size.

It is important we raise public awareness of the need to conserve water and to implement the requirements to meet the state of California Water Conservation Landscape Act.
