CAL FIRE/Riverside County Firefighters are on-scene of a commercial structure fire involving a single-story strip mall in Canyon Lake. First arriving units reported the west wing of the 8-unit, 10,000 square foot strip mall well-involved with heavy fire. Firefighters are in defensive-attack mode. Updates will be posted as information becomes available.

UPDATE 9:45 a.m.: The strip mall was declared a total loss. Damage estimates are pending. Two firefighters sustained minor heat-related injuries. One of which was treated at the scene and the second was transported by ground ambulance to a local hospital. Additional updates will be posted as information becomes available.
