Additionally, plans are moving forward for the City of Canyon Lake's third annual Veterans Day recognition on November 11, 2011. The event will be held in the parking area around the pocket park in the center of the Canyon Lake Towne Center. Plans are underway to renovate the park in cooperation with the Canyon Lake Merchant Owners Association. Renovation includes construction of a black granite monument to honor all veteran and active duty military.

The City's Veterans Day planning committee will meet on June 21, 2011 at 3 pm in the Municipal Board Room and all who want to help are invited to attend. The committee is looking for sponsorships for the November 11 event. Sponsorship levels are as follows:
